

[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7683, February 23, 1994]

**AN ACT TO DECLARE THE 22ND DAY OF JULY OF EVERY YEAR A
NONWORKING SPECIAL PUBLIC HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCE OF
BOHOL AND THE CITY OF TAGBILARAN TO BE KNOWN AS
"BOHOL DAY"**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

SECTION 1. On July 22, 1854, Bohol was separated from Cebu and, together with Siquijor, was created into a politico-military province during the Spanish rule in the Philippines. Thereafter, it was recognized as a province during the American regime.

SEC. 2. July 22 of every year is hereby declared a special nonworking public holiday in the Province of Bohol and the City of Tagbilaran.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
