[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7039, May 27, 1991]

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY BAY-ANG, MUNICIPALITY OF AJUY, PROVINCE OF ILOILO, TO BE KNOWN AS THE BAY-ANG NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. There shall be established a national high school in Barangay Bay-ang, Municipality of Ajuy, Province of Iloilo, to be known as the Bay-ang National High School.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of the Department of Education, Culture and Sports shall issue such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

SEC. 3. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act is hereby authorized to be appropriated in the General Appropriations Act of the year following its enactment into law and thereafter.

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
