

**[ REPUBLIC ACT NO. 6709, February 10, 1989 ]**

**AN ACT DECLARING NOVEMBER FIVE OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL  
NON-WORKING HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCE OF NEGROS  
OCCIDENTAL**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in  
Congress assembled:*

SECTION 1. November five of every year is hereby declared a special non-working  
holiday in the Province of Negros Occidental.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
