

**[ REPUBLIC ACT NO. 4792, June 18, 1966 ]**

**AN ACT GRANTING ZOILO DEJARESCO, JR., A FRANCHISE TO CONSTRUCT, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE TELEVISION AND RADIO BROADCASTING STATIONS IN THE PROVINCE OF BOHOL.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

SECTION 1. Subject to the provisions of the Constitution, Zoiilo Dejaresco, Jr. is hereby granted for a period of twenty-five years a franchise to construct, maintain and operate, for commercial purposes and in the public interest, television and radio broadcasting stations in the Province of Bohol: Provided, That this franchise shall be void unless the construction of at least one television station or one radio broadcasting station be begun within four years from the date of approval of this Act, and be completed within five years from said date: Provided, further, That the grantee shall provide adequate public service time to enable the Government, through the said television and radio broadcasting stations, to reach the population on important public issues; shall assist in the functions of public information and education; shall conform to the ethics of honest enterprise; and shall not use his stations for the broadcasting and/or telecasting of or indecent language, speech, act or scene, or for dissemination of deliberately false information or willful misrepresentation, or to the detriment of the public health or to incite, encourage, or assist in subversive or treasonable acts.

SEC. 2. Such provisions of Act Numbered Thirty-eight hundred forty-six. Entitled "An Act providing for the regulation of radio stations and radio communications in the Philippine Islands, and for other Purposes;" Act Numbered Thirty-nine hundred ninety-seven, known as the radio Broadcasting Law; Commonwealth Act Numbered One hundred forty-six, known as the Public Service Act, and their amendments, as are applicable to radio broadcasting station shall be applied, as far as practicable to the television stations referred to in Section one hereof.

SEC. 3. As a condition of the granting of this franchise, the grantee shall execute a bond in favor of the Government of the Philippines, in the sum of fifty thousand pesos, in form and with sureties satisfactory to the Secretary of Public Works and Communications, conditioned upon the faithful performance of the grantee's hereunder during the first three years of the life of this franchise. If, after four years from the date of acceptance of this franchise, the grantee shall have fulfilled said obligations, or as soon thereafter as the grantee shall have fulfilled the same, the bond aforesaid shall be cancelled by the Secretary of Public Works and Communications.

SEC. 4. Acceptance in this franchise shall be given in writing within six months after the approval of this Act. When so accepted by the grantee and upon approval of the bond aforesaid by the Secretary of Public Works and Communications, the grantee
