[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 3760, June 22, 1963]

AN ACT GRANTING CESAR T. ROSALES A FRANCHISE TO INSTALL, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE AN ELECTRIC LIGHT, HEAT AND POWER SYSTEM, AND AN ICE PLANT AND COLD STORAGE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MALUNAY, PROVINCE OF QUEZON, AND TO SELL AND DISTRIBUTE ELECTRIC LIGHT, HEAT AND POWER AND SUPPLY COLD STORAGE THEREIN, AND TO SELL AND DISTRIBUTE ICE IN THE ADJOINING MUNICIPALITIES, NAMELY: PITOGO, MACALELON, GENERAL, LUNA, CATANAUAN, AURORA, SAN ANDRES, SAN NARCISO, BUENAVISTA AND GUINAYANGAN, ALL IN THE SAME PROVINCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION. 1. Subject to the terms and conditions established in this Act and in Act Numbered Thirty-six hundred id thirty-six, as amended by Commonwealth Act Numbered One hundred and thirty-two, and to the provisions of the Constitution, there is granted to Cesar T. Rosales, herein after called the grantee, for a period of fifty years from the approval of this Act, the right, privilege and authority to install, maintain and operate electric light, heat and power system, and an ice plant and cold storage in the Municipality of Malunay, Province of Quezon, and to sell and distribute electric light, heat and power and supply cold storage therein; and to sell and distribute ice in the adjoining municipalities, namely: Pitogo, Macalelon, General Luna Catanauan, Aurora, San Andres, San Narciso, Buenavista and Guinayangan, all in the same province, and to charge and collect a schedule of prices and rates for the electric light, heat, power, ice and cold storage so furnish, which schedule of prices and rates shall at all times be subject to regulation by the Public Service Commission

SEC. 2. In the event that the grantee shall purchase a secure from the National Power Corporation electric heat and power, the National Power Corporation is hereby authorized to negotiate and transact for the benefit and in behalf of the public consumers with reference to rates.

SEC. 3. The grantee shall manufacture ice and supply cold storage up to the limit of the capacity of his plant.

SEC. 4. All the apparatus and appurtenances to be used by the grantee shall be modern, safe and first class in every respect and the grantee shall, whenever the Public Service Commission shall determine that public interest reasonably requires it, change or alter any of his apparatus and appurtenances at grantee's expense.
