[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 3443, June 18, 1961]

AN ACT CONVERTING THE CEBU SOUTH PROVINCIAL HIGH SCHOOL INTO A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS THE CEBU SOUTH NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL OF THE NECESSARY FUNDS THEREFOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The Cebu South Provincial High School is hereby converted into a national high school, to be known as the Cebu South National High School. Comprehensive curriculum which includes both academic and vocational courses shall be offered. The Secretary of Education is hereby empowered to reorganize the said school accordingly.

Upon organization of the Cebu South National High School, the assets, liabilities, personnel, equipment and records of the Cebu South Provincial High School shall stand transferred to the Cebu South National High School.

SEC. 2. The sum of one hundred thousand pesos is hereby authorized to be appropriated, out of any funds, in the National Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the operation and maintenance of the said school for the fiscal year nineteen hundred sixty-one and nineteen hundred sixty-two. Thereafter, the necessary sum for the operation of the said school shall be included in the annual General Appropriation Acts.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Enacted, without Executive approval, June 18, 1961.
