

[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 2653, June 18, 1960]

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SCHOOL OF ARTS AND TRADES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PANDAN, PROVINCE OF CATANDUANES, AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS THEREFOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. There shall be established, under the supervision of the Director of Public Schools, a school of arts and trades in the Municipality of Pandan, Province of Catanduanes, to be known as the Pandan School of Arts and Trades.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of Education shall issue such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

SEC. 3. The sum of two hundred thousand pesos is hereby authorized to be appropriated, out of any funds in the National Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the establishment, operation and maintenance of said school during the fiscal year nineteen hundred sixty. Such sums as may be needed for the same purpose in subsequent year shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
