

[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 1204, April 20, 1955]

AN ACT TO AMEND THE FIRST PARAGRAPH OF SECTION TWENTY-FOUR OF ACT NUMBERED THIRTY-NINE HUNDRED AND NINETY-TWO, AS AMENDED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section twenty-four of Act Numbered Thirty-nine hundred and ninety-two, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 24. *Driver's license, fees, examination.*—Every person who desires personally to operate any motor ver should make application to the Chief, Motor Vehicles Office, or his deputies for a license to drive motor vehicles: *Provided, however,* That no person shall be issued a professional driver's license unless he has first obtain a police clearance, which shall be issued without charge or fee, from the police department of the city or municipality in which he resides: *And provided, further,* That rson should be issued a professional driver's license who is suffering from highly contagious diseases, such as, advanced tuberculosis, gonorrhea, syphilis, and the like".

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
