

**[ REPUBLIC ACT NO. 377, June 14, 1949 ]**

**AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TWO OF REPUBLIC ACT NUMBERED TWO HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SIX.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

SECTION 1. Section two of Republic Act Numbered Two hundred and eighty-six is amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 2. The boundaries and limits of the territory said municipality are established and defined as follows:

"Starting from a point in the intersection of latitude  $5^{\circ} 04' 00''$  North, and longitude  $123^{\circ} 10' 00''$  East going in a straight line eastward to the provincial boundary line between Zamboanga and Misamis Occidental, thence northward along that same provincial boundary up to the line defined by latitude  $8^{\circ} 20' 00''$  North, thence westward along that same latitude  $8^{\circ} 20' 00''$  North until it intersects the longitude  $123^{\circ} 10' 00''$  East, thence southward in a straight line down to the starting point."

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
