

[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 88, October 30, 1946]

AN ACT APPROPRIATING FIFTY-SEVEN MILLION SIXTY-FIVE THOUSAND PESOS FOR PUBLIC WORKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any funds in the National Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be at the disposal of the Secretary of Public Works and Communications and subject to the provisions hereinafter set forth, for the purposes mentioned hereunder:

| (a) For the investigation, survey construction, reconstruction, repair, improvement, extension, and completion of public works and purchase of school sites in provinces, chartered cities and municipalities to be distributed among the Representative Districts: Provided, That where appropriations are authorized for the reconstruction of roads and bridges, the provinces, chartered cities or municipalities concerned shall provide annually the necessary appropriations for establishing an adequate system of maintenance for all provincial, city and municipal roads now in existence and those herein authorize | P8,000,000.00 |
