[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 45, October 03, 1946]

AN ACT TO FIX THE DATE OF THE REGULAR ELECTIONS FOR ELECTIVE PROVINCIAL, CITY AND MUNICIPAL OFFICES, AND OF THE ELECTION OF THE EIGHT SENATORS WHO WILL SUCCEED THOSE WHOSE TERM OF OFFICE WILL EXPIRE ON DECEMBER THIRTIETH, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND FORTY-SEVEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. On the second Tuesday of November, nineteen hundred and fortyseven, and on the same day every four years thereafter, a regular election shall be held to elect the officials who will occupy all elective provincial, city and municipal offices throughout the Philippines. The officials elected shall assume office on the first day of January next following and shall hold such office for four years or until their successors shall have been duly elected and qualified.

SEC. 2. The election of the eight Senators who will succeed those whose term of office will expire on the thirtieth day of December, nineteen hundred and forty-seven, shall also be held on the second Tuesday of November, nineteen hundred and forty-seven.

SEC. 3. All laws or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
