

**[ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 465, April 28,
1983]**

**CREATING A NATIONAL COMMITTEE TO TAKE CHARGE OF
CELEBRATION OF PHILIPPINE INDEPENDENCE DAY ON JUNE 12,
1983**
