

**[ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 211, March 25,
1970]**

**AMENDING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 50 DATED APRIL 18,
1967, ENTITLED "CREATING A PRESIDENTIAL INVESTIGATION
COMMITTEE."**

I, ALEJANDRO MELCHOR, Acting Executive Secretary, by order of the President of the Philippines, do hereby amend Administrative Order No. 50, dated April 18, 1967, so as to authorize the Chairman or any member thereof to summon witnesses, administer oaths and take testimony of evidence relevant to the investigation of any case assigned to him by the Committee. The deliberations on a case and the recommendation thereon shall be made by the Committee as a body or by at least two members.
