

[ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 39, June 27, 1937]

ADDITIONAL ALLOTMENTS FOR THE PAYMENT OF INCREASES IN SALARIES AND WAGES AUTHORIZED IN ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 25.

Whereas, the allotments made in Administrative Order Numbered Twenty-five, nineteen hundred and thirty-six series, for the payment of the increases in salaries and wages required by Executive Orders Numbered Forty-nine and Fifty, nineteen hundred and thirty-six series, have not been sufficient in some cases, while unexpended balances have been left in others; and

Whereas, it is necessary to make a reallocation of the said unexpended balances and to authorize additional allotments out of the unallotted balance of the appropriation under Commonwealth Act Numbered Thirty-seven to cover the deficits referred to;

Now, therefore, I, Manuel L. Quezon, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Constitution and the existing laws, hereby order the reversion to the unallotted balance, of the appropriation under Commonwealth Act Numbered Thirty-seven of the following unexpended balances of the allotments made in Administrative Order Numbered Twenty-five, nineteen hundred and thirty-six series:
