## [ EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 470, July 21, 1976 ]

## MODIFYING THE RATE OF IMPORT DUTY ON CERTAIN IMPORTED ARTICLES AS PROVIDED UNDER REPUBLIC ACT NO. 1937, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE TARIFF AND CUSTOMS CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES, AS AMENDED

Pursuant to the powers vested in me by Section 401 of Republic Act No. 1937, as amended, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, do hereby direct and order:

SECTION 1. The article specifically listed hereunder as classified under Section 104 of Republic Act No. 1937 shall pay the following rate of import duty:

Hydrogen peroxide ad val. 50%

(including solid hydrogen peroxide)

SECTION 2. After the expiration of thirty (30) days from the issuance of this Order, the above-described article entered or withdrawn from warehouse, in the Philippines, for consumption shall be subject to the rate of import duty herein prescribed.

SECTION 3. Any unwarranted increase in the prices of local products benefitted by this tariff change may be sufficient ground for the revocation of such tariff change.
