

[EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 75, July 14, 1967]

**CREATING A SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON BAGUIO SQUATTERS
PROBLEM**

By virtue of the powers vested in me by law, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, do hereby create a committee to study and work out the establishment of squatter relocation sites within Baguio City, said sites to be excluded from the Baguio Townsite Reservation and disposed of under the provisions of the Public Land Act, and to promulgate rules and regulations relative thereto, composed of the following:

The District Land Officer	Chairman
The City Engineer.	Member
The City Fiscal.	Member
A representative of the Presidential Assistant on Housing.	Member

The Committee may call upon any department, bureau, office, agency or instrumentality of the government for such assistance as it may need to carry out its task.

The Committee shall submit its report to the President within one month from the date hereof.

Done in the City of Manila, this 14th day of July, in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.
