

**[ EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 421, March 08, 1951 ]**

**AMENDING SECTION ONE OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBERED  
THREE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE, EXECUTIVE ORDER  
NUMBERED THREE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-TWO AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES**

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 3 of Republic Act No. 509, entitled "An Act declaring national policy, authorizing the President of the Philippines for a limited period to fix ceiling prices of commodities and to promulgate rules and regulations regarding prices of commodities to effectuate such policy, and authorizing the appropriation of a certain sum for the purpose," and upon the recommendation of the Price Administration Board, 7, Elpidio Quirino, President of the Philippines, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. Section one of Executive Order No. 331, dated July 7, 1950, is hereby amended by increasing and setting up new ceiling prices for American and Canadian flour, as follows:

**FOODSTUFF (IMPORTED)**

3rd Class	Bag/50#	7.05
Canadian 1st Class	Bag/50#	7.83

SEC 2. Section one of Executive Order No. 352, dated October 6, 1950, is hereby amended by increasing and setting up new ceiling prices for Hills Bros. coffee, as follows:

Commodity	Unit	Importer's price	Wholesale price	Retail ceiling price
Coffee roasted: Hills Bros. Coffee	24/1-lb	P57.01/cs	P61.84/cs.	P2.88/tin

SEC. 3. The ceiling prices fixed in this Order include the 7 per cent sales tax and 1 per cent municipal tax.

SEC. 4. This Order shall take effect immediately.
