## [ EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 3, July 10, 1946 ]

## ON THE CONTROL OF EXPORTS FROM THE PHILIPPINES

By the virtue of the powers vested in me under Commonwealth Act No. 728, entitled "An Act to prohibit certain exports from the Philippines, to authorize the President of the Philippines to regulate, control, curtail and prohibit said exports, to provide penalties for the violation of this Act and of regulations issued pursuant thereto, and for other purposes," I, Manuel Roxas, President of the Republic of the Philippines, do hereby order:

**SECTION 1** . Except as permitted in section 3 and 4 of this Order, the exportation of the following is hereby prohibited until further orders:

- 1. Rice
- 2. Sugar
- 3. Milk
- 4. Cheese
- 5. Butter and imitations thereof
- 6. Eggs and preparations thereof
- 7. Lard and substitutes thereof
- 8. Poultry, meat, soap, fish, and preparations thereof
- 9. Grains, seeds, cereals, and preparations thereof
- 10. Pulses, vegetables, fruits, nuts (except coconuts) and preparations thereof
- 11. Coffee
- 12. Cacao and preparations thereof
- 13. Textiles and manufactures thereof
- 14. Cotton and light material
- 15. Shoes
- 16. Soap
- 17. Fertilizer
- 18. Pigments
- 19. Paints
