

[EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 3, July 10, 1946]

ON THE CONTROL OF EXPORTS FROM THE PHILIPPINES

By the virtue of the powers vested in me under Commonwealth Act No. 728, entitled "An Act to prohibit certain exports from the Philippines, to authorize the President of the Philippines to regulate, control, curtail and prohibit said exports, to provide penalties for the violation of this Act and of regulations issued pursuant thereto, and for other purposes," I, Manuel Roxas, President of the Republic of the Philippines, do hereby order:

SECTION 1 . Except as permitted in section 3 and 4 of this Order, the exportation of the following is hereby prohibited until further orders:

1. Rice
2. Sugar
3. Milk
4. Cheese
5. Butter and imitations thereof
6. Eggs and preparations thereof
7. Lard and substitutes thereof
8. Poultry, meat, soap, fish, and preparations thereof
9. Grains, seeds, cereals, and preparations thereof
10. Pulses, vegetables, fruits, nuts (except coconuts) and preparations thereof
11. Coffee
12. Cacao and preparations thereof
13. Textiles and manufactures thereof
14. Cotton and light material
15. Shoes
16. Soap
17. Fertilizer
18. Pigments
19. Paints
