**MAKING ALLOTMENTS OF THE APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE
PHILIPPINE ARMY AUTHORIZED BY COMMONWEALTH ACT NO.
300, IN ADDITION TO THOSE INCLUDED IN EXECUTIVE ORDER
NO. 190, CURRENT SERIES, FOR EXPENDITURES OF THE
EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENTS OF THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT
DURING THE PERIOD FROM JANUARY 1 TO JUNE 30, 1939**

The following allotments of appropriations authorized by Commonwealth Act Numbered Three hundred are made for the Philippine Army in addition to those included in Executive Order Numbered One hundred and ninety, dated February twenty-eighth, nineteen hundred and thirty-nine, for expenditures of the executive departments of the National Government during the period from January first to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and thirty-nine:
