IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES FOR THE REGISTRATION OF AQUACULTURE STRUCTURES IN THE LAGUNA DE BAY AND THE SEVEN CRATER LAKES

Adopted: 20 March 2015 Date Filed: 01 April 2015

To effectively and efficiently regulate the aquaculture operations in the Laguna de Bay and the Seven Crater Lakes, the following guidelines shall serve as basis for the registration of fishpens and fishcages.

I. Registration Period

The registration period of aquaculture structures shall commence on the first working day of January, until last working day of June of the current year.

II. Scope of Coverage

This Implementing Rules and Regulations/Guidelines shall cover all fishpens and fishcages in the Laguna de Bay and the Seven Crater Lakes.

III. Qualification of Registrants

The prospective registrants shall adhere to the following guidelines as basis for acceptance of their registration papers/documents:

- A. Must have existing and operational structure within the 1996 and 1999 fishpen/fishcage belt, pursuant to the Zoning and Management Plan (ZOMAP), based on the allocated and verified area;
- B. Previously registered and had paid in full the corresponding fishpen/fishcage fee and related charges;
- C. Must have submitted complete set of documentary requirements for registration hereunder identified;

1. Fishpens

- 1.1 Duly accomplished and notarized LLDA Application Form;
- 1.2 Latest General Information Sheet (GIS) from SEC;
- 1.3 Business Permit/Mayor's Permit (Current Year);
- 1.4 Latest Financial Statement (Balance Sheet and Income Statement); and
