## ADDENDUM TO CMO NO. 7-2008 AMENDING CMO 17-2005 ON THE MORATORIUM ON APPROVALS TO ESTABLISH/OPERATE OFF DOCK CYCFS, CUSTOMS PUBLIC/PRIVATE BONDED WAREHOUSES, COMMON BONDED WAREHOUSES AND OTHER NON-MANUFACTURING BONDED WAREHOUSES/FACILITIES

Section 4 of Customs Memorandum Order No. 17-2005 is hereby amended to read, as follows:

"SECTION 4. The moratorium shall not cover-however, applications for the establishment and operation of Customs Bonded Manufacturing Warehouses pursuant to Section 2001 to 2004 of the Tariff and Customs Code of the Philippines as amended, as well as applications for accreditation as member of an existing Common Bonded Warehouses <u>and</u> <u>applications for registration of qualified end-user clients (except BQI-DTI registered firms) of existing ICBWs pursuant to CMO 39-91 and CAO 7-2007/CAO 7-2003, respectively, provided that the applicant manufacturing firm is NOT engaged in the importation of any type of <u>RESINS as raw material/s.</u>"</u>

Henceforth, the Chairman, Customs Bonded Warehouse Committee is hereby advised that all applications of this nature, except those filed on or before <u>February</u> <u>15,2008</u>. shall outrightfy be denied until further instructions from the undersigned.

All orders, Memoranda, Circulars, or parts thereof which are inconsistent herewith shall be deemed repealed and/or modified accordingly.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall last until revoked.
