[SRA CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 29, January 23, 1992]

GUIDELINE TO IMPLEMENT SRA SUGAR ORDER NO. 5 DATED 21 JANUARY 1992

For the information and guidance of all concerned, the following rules and regulations are hereby issued to implement the provisions of SRA Sugar Order No. 5, dated 21 January 1992:

SECTION 1. All integrated mills, (mills with sugar refineries, to include Busco Sugar Milling Co. with Busco Sugar Refinery) authorized to refine all their production are hereby prohibited from refining "B-1" Domestic (Reserve) sugar, classified in said STA Sugar Order No. 5, until after the maturity dates indicated in quedan-permits covering thereof.

SECTION 2. The dates of issuance of quedan-permits to be issued to cover "B-1" sugar as well as corresponding maturity dates thereof shall be clearly indicated in said quedan-permits.

SECTION 3. All sugar mills are hereby directed to immediately place their individual orders for the printing of additional "B" quedan-permit forms with the Documentation Division, Production Control and Regulation Office, Sugar Regulatory Administration, Diliman, Quezon City. The word "B-1" shall be stamped at the upper right hand corner of the three portions of each quedan-permit. The mill companies shall submit, to said Division, a weekly report of serial numbers, with corresponding LKg values, issued to cover "B-1" sugar within one week from issuance date thereof.

SECTION 4. This Circular Letter takes effect immediately.

SECTION 5. The provisions of sugar orders, circular letters, rules and regulations inconsistent with or contrary to this Circular Letter are hereby amended, modified or revoked accordingly.
