It appearing that the offense for which JORGIE CONST. was blacklisted under Department Order No. 127 dated May 20, 1991, is the commission of act which tends to defeat the purpose of public bidding of government projects in the Masbate Engineering District which is punishable only for a period of one (1) year pursuant to IB 10.5(3) of the Implementing Rules and Regulations, as amended, of PD 1594 since this is its first offense and it appearing further that JORGIE CONSTRUCTION has already served the one year suspension period, upon request of the proprietor of JORGIE Construction, the suspension/blacklisting imposed on said firm under Department Order No. 127, Series of 1991, is hereby lifted effective immediately.
