Set of two garments put up for retail sale made up of: (a) a lightweight knitted garment (100% cotton) printed with a multi-coloured pattern of motifs intended to cover the upper part of the body, with long sleeves and a close fitting neckline which partially opens at the front and is fastened right over left. This garment has applied ribbing at the neckline, at the ends of the sleeves and of the bottom, of the same colour as the trousers	6108 31 90 Category: 24	Classification is determined by the provisions of General Rules 1 and 6 for the interpretation of the combined Nomenclature as well as by the wording of CN codes 6108, 6108 31 and 6108 31 90. Taking into account the general appearance of the garments and the lightness of the fabric, this set is to be regarded as a pair of pyjamas.
