

## [ PROCLAMATION NO. 936, March 24, 2020 ]

### **DECLARING THURSDAY, 02 APRIL 2020, A SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE PROVINCE OF BATAAN**

**WHEREAS**, 02 April 2020, Thursday, will mark the celebration of the birth anniversary of Francisco "Balagtas" Baltazar, a prominent Filipino poet and orator;

**WHEREAS**, Francisco "Balagtas" Baltazar, a notable Tagalog writer, married a maiden from Orion, Bataan, resided in the town of Orion, became productive in his art form, and died in the same town in 1862; and

**WHEREAS**, it is but fitting and proper that the people of the Province of Bataan be given full opportunity to celebrate and participate in the occasion with appropriate ceremonies;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, SALVADOR C. MEDIALDEA**, Executive Secretary, by authority of the President, **RODRIGO ROA DUTERTE**, do hereby declare Thursday, 02 April 2020, a special (non-working) day in the Province of Bataan.
