DECLARING MONDAY, 18 FEBRUARY 2019, A SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE CITY OF BAYAWAN, PROVINCE OF NEGROS ORIENTAL

WHEREAS, the City of Bayawan, Province of Negros Oriental, will celebrate the *Tawo-Tawo* Festival on the fourth week of February;

WHEREAS, the *Tawo-Tawo* Festival reflects the culture of the City of Bayawan being a rice granary of the southern part of the Province of Negros Oriental;
