

[PROCLAMATION NO. 829, October 25, 2019]

DECLARING MONDAY, 28 OCTOBER 2019, AS A SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DINGLE, PROVINCE OF ILOILO

WHEREAS, the First Battle Cry of Revolution against Spain in the Province of Iloilo and the Island of Panay, known as the "Cry of Lincud," happened on 28 October 1898 in Barrio Lincud, Dingle, **Iloilo**;

WHEREAS, on 28 October 2019, Monday, the Municipality of Dingle, Province of Iloilo, will mark the commemoration of the "Cry of Lincud"; and

WHEREAS, it is but fitting and proper that the people of the Municipality of Dingle be given full opportunity to celebrate and participate in the occasion with appropriate ceremonies;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SALVADOR C. MEDIALDEA, Executive Secretary, by authority of the President, **RODRIGO ROA DUTERTE**, do hereby declare Monday, 28 October 2019, a special (non-working) day in the Municipality of Dingle, Province of Iloilo.
