

**[ PROCLAMATION NO. 436, February 21, 2018 ]**

**DECLARING SATURDAY, 31 MARCH 2018, AS A SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE PROVINCE OF SOUTHERN LEYTE**

**WHEREAS** , the first mass in the Philippines was celebrated in the Island of Limasawa, Province of Southern Leyte on 31 March 1521;

**WHEREAS** , Saturday, 31 March 2018, marks the commemoration of the First Mass in the Philippines in Limasawa Island, Southern Leyte; and

**WHEREAS** , it is but fitting and proper that the people of the Province of Southern Leyte be given full opportunity to celebrate and participate in the occasion with appropriate ceremonies;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, SALVADOR C. MEDIALDEA**, Executive Secretary, by authority of the President, **RODRIGO ROA DUTERTE**, do hereby declare Saturday, 31 March 2018, as a special (non-working) day in the Province of Southern Leyte,
