

[ **PROCLAMATION NO. 326, October 04, 2017** ]

**DECLARING SATURDAY, 28 OCTOBER 2017, AS A SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DINGLE, PROVINCE OF ILOILO**

**WHEREAS**, the First Battle Cry of Revolution against Spain in the Province of Iloilo and the Island of Panay, known as the "Cry of Lincud," happened on 28 October 1898 in Barrio Lincud Dingle, Iloilo; and

**WHEREAS**, in order for the people of the Municipality of Dingle, IloIlo to celebrate and participate in the event the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan of Dingle has requested that Saturday 28 October 2017 be declared as a special non-working day;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, SALVADOR C. MEDIALDEA**, Executive Secretary, by authority of the President **RODRIGO ROA DUTERTE**, do hereby declare Saturday, 28 October 2017, as a special (non-working) day in the Municipality of Dingle, Province of Iloilo.
