

[PROCLAMATION NO. 65, September 19, 2016]

DECLARING FRIDAY, 28 OCTOBER 2016, AS A SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DINGLE, PROVINCE OF ILOILO

WHEREAS, the First Battle Cry of Revolution against Spain in the Province of Iloilo and Island of Panay, known as the "Cry of Lincud" happened on 28 October 1898;

WHEREAS, in order for the people of the Municipality of Dingle, Iloilo to celebrate and participate in the event, the Sangguniang Bayan has requested that Friday, 28 October 2016 be declared as a special non-working day.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SALVADOR C. MEDIALDEA, Executive Secretary, by authority of the President, RODRIGO ROA DUTERTE, do hereby declare Friday, 28 October 2016, as a special (non-working) day in the Municipality of Dingle, Province of Iloilo.
