

[PROCLAMATION NO. 91, October 24, 2016]

DECLARING FRIDAY, 28 OCTOBER 2016, AS A SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE CITY OF MATI, PROVINCE OF DAVAO ORIENTAL

WHEREAS, the City of Mati celebrates the *Sambuokan Festival* every last weekend of October in commemoration of its date of establishment as a Municipality before eventually becoming a City;
