DECLARING WEDNESDAY, 28 OCTOBER 2015, AS A SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DINGLE, PROVINCE OF ILOILO

WHEREAS, the First Battle Cry of Revolution against Spain in the Province of Iloilo and Island of Panay, known as the "Cry of Lincud", happened on 28 October 1898;
