

[**PROCLAMATION NO. 1647, October 15, 2008**]

DECLARING MONDAY, NOVEMBER 24, 2008, AS SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE PROVINCE OF BENGUET

WHEREAS, Sunday, November 23, 2008, marks the Foundation Day anniversary of the Province of Benguet;

WHEREAS, to enable the people of the Province of La Union celebrate the occasion, the Office of the Governor requested that Monday, November 24, 2008 be declared as a special non-working day instead of November 23, 2008, which falls on a Sunday;
