**DECLARING THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 27, 2007, AS SPECIAL
(NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MALVAR,
PROVINCE OF BATANGAS**

WHEREAS, Thursday, September 27, 2007, marks the birth anniversary of General Miguel Malvar, the last general of the Philippine Revolution to surrender to the Americans;
