

[PROCLAMATION NO. 1040, March 27, 2006]

**AMENDING PROCLAMATION NO. 273 DATED APRIL 23, 2000
WHICH ESTABLISHED THE ROOSEVELT PROTECTED LANDSCAPE
BY SEGREGATING A PORTION OF THE LAND EMBRACED THEREIN
AND DECLARING THE SAME AS CIVIL RESERVATION FOR PUBLIC
USE OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF DINALUPIHAN, BATAAN**

Upon recommendation of the Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources, and pursuant to the authority vested in me be law, **I, GLORIA MACAPAGAL ARROYO**, President of the Republic of the Philippines, do amend Proclamation No. 273 dated April 23, 2000 which established the Roosevelt Protected Landscape by segregating a portion of the land embraced therein containing an area of **TWELVE THOUSAND SEVENTY NINE (12,079) Square Meters** located in Brgy. Roosevelt, Municipality of Dinalupihan, Province of Bataan, Island of Luzon, and declares the same as Civil Reservations of public use of the Local Government Unit of Dinalupihan, Bataan, subject to private rights, if any there be, and to actual survey, which parcel of land is more particularly described as follows:

TECHNICAL DESCRIPTION

"A PARCEL OF LAND, situated in Barangay Roosevelt, Municipality of Dinalupihan, Province of Bataan, Island of Luzon.

Bounded on the NE., ALONG LINES 1-2-3 BY Public Land; on the SE., along line 3-4 by Road; on the SW., along lines 4-5-6 by residential area; along line 6-1 by Barangay Road.

Beginning at a point marked '1' being N. 80 deg. 37' E', 244.84 m. from MBM No.15, Hermosa Cadastre, thence:

S. 80 deg. 13' E., 102.97 m. to point 2;
S. 36 deg. 21' E., 98.47 m. to point 3;
S. 71 deg. 29' W., 124.93 m. to point 4;
N. 06 deg. 42' W., 82.13 m. to point 5;
N. 82 deg. 51' W., 25.00 m to point 6;
N. 07 deg. 09' W., 58.36 m. to point of

Beginning, containing an area of **TWELVE THOUSAND SEVENTY NINE (12,079) square meters**, more or less.

All points are marked on the ground by Old Points."

The tract of land herein reserved shall automatically form part of the Roosevelt Protected Landscape in the event the Local Government of Dinalupihan ceased from utilizing the area.
