

[PROCLAMATION NO. 788, February 09, 2005]

DECLARING THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 24, 2005, AS SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE PROVINCE OF ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY
