

[PROCLAMATION NO. 870, June 29, 2005]

**DECLARING THE PERIOD FROM SEPTEMBER 19 TO 25, 2005 AS
"PRINTING INDUSTRY WEEK"**

WHEREAS, the continued emergence of cutting edge technologies and the increasing competitiveness of the global printing market is an ever present challenge to the industry;
