

[PROCLAMATION NO. 869, June 27, 2005]

RESERVING FOR SCHOOL SITE PURPOSES OF THE PHILIPPINE CRAFTSMAN SCHOOL, A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND OF THE PUBLIC DOMAIN SITUATED IN BRGY. MAGARA, MUNICIPALITY OF ROXAS, PROVINCE OF PALAWAN, ISLAND OF PALAWAN

Upon recommendation of the Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources, and by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, **I, GLORIA MACAPAGAL ARROYO**, President of the Republic of the Philippines, do hereby withdraw from entry, sale, disposition or settlement and reserve for school site purposes of the **PHILIPPINE CRAFTSMEN SCHOOL** under the administration of the Department of Education, a certain parcel of land of the public domain located at Brgy. Magara, Municipality of Roxas, Province of Palawan, Island of Palawan, containing an area of **TWENTY NINE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED NINETY THREE (29, 293) SQUARE METERS**, subject to private rights, if any there be, which parcel of land is more particularly described as follows:

LOT NO. 2751, CAD-862-D, CASE 10

A PARCEL OF LAND (Lot No. 2751, Cad-862-D, Case 10, being a portion of Lot 1032, Pls-7980, situated in Brgy. Magara, Municipality of Roxas, Province of Palawan, Island of Palawan.

Bounded on the East, along lines 7-1-2-3 by National Road; on the North, along line 3-4 by Lot No. 2950; on the East, along lines 4-5-6 by Road; and on the South, along line 6-7 by Road.

Beginning at a point marked "1" on plan being S. 65 deg. 07' W., 16, 373.25 meters from BLLM No. 1, Roxas Cadastre, thence:
