## DECLARING FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2005, AS SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE PROVINCE OF QUEZON

**WHEREAS,** Friday, November 4, 2005, marks the 164th death anniversary of Apolinario de la Cruz, better known as "Hermano Pule", the great man from Lukban, Quezon;

**WHEREAS,** Hermano Pule rendered invaluable service in our country by founding the brotherhood popularly known as Confradia De Jesus;

**WHEREAS,** the brotherhood or religious organization that Hermano Pule founded spread like wildfire in the Province of Tayabas (now Quezon, Laguna and some towns in Batangas) which historical research has proved as one way of showing nationalism during that time;

**WHEREAS,** it is but fitting and proper to honor and emulate the heroism and patriotism of Apolinario (Hermano Pule) de la Cruz and give the people of Quezon Province full opportunity to commemorate the vent with appropriate ceremonies.
