

[PROCLAMATION NO. 438, August 11, 2003]

**DECLARING THE PERIOD FROM OCTOBER 1 TO 6, 2003 AS
"PRINTING INDUSTRY WEEK"**

WHEREAS, the printing industry serves as a vehicle in promoting the country's arts and culture;

WHEREAS, the printing industry, as one of the most effective tools in communication, contributes to the furtherance of the country's goal towards national economic growth;

WHEREAS, the Printing Industries Association of the Philippines, Inc. will hold its 11th National Printers Convention on October 2 to 4, 2003 with the theme *"Doing Better Business During Challenging Times"*.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to focus national attention on the vital role played by the printing industry in promoting the government's higher objectives.
