

[PROCLAMATION NO. 543, November 07, 1958]

**DECLARING THE FOURTH WEEK OF NOVEMBER, 1958, AS
BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONAL WOMEN'S WEEK**

In recognition of the important role being played by business and professional women in the promotion of the economic and social welfare of our country and people, I, Carlos P. Garcia, President of the Philippines, do hereby declare the fourth week of November, 1958, as Business and Professional Women's Week. I call upon all citizens and residents of the Philippines, irrespective of nationality or creed, to cooperate in the celebration of this week so that the contribution of business and professional women to the economy of the country as well as the problems brought about by their dual role as homemakers and earners will be brought to the attention of the whole country.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 7th day of November, in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight, and of the Independence of the Philippines, the thirteenth.
