

[PROCLAMATION NO. 403, June 27, 1953]

EXCLUDING FROM THE OPERATION OF PROCLAMATION NO. 88, SERIES OF 1936, DESIGNATING A PORTION OF THE REGAN BARRACKS FEDERAL RESERVATION AS PHILIPPINE ARMY POST, CERTAIN PORTIONS OF THE LAND EMBRACED THEREIN AND RESERVING THE SAME FOR SCHOOL SITE PURPOSES, SITUATED IN DARAGA, ALBAY, NOW CITY OF LEGASPI.

Upon the recommendation of the Secretary of Agriculture and Natural Resources and by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, I hereby exclude from the operation of Proclamation No. 88, series of 1936, designating as Philippine Army Post a portion of the Regan Barracks Federal Reservation, certain portions of the land embraced and reserving the same for school site purposes, under the administration of the Director of Public Schools, subject to private rights, if any there be, situated in Daraga, Albay, now City of Legaspi, which parcels of land are more particularly described as follows:

BOUNDED on the NE., by Portion of Lot 6068 (Military Reservation); on the SE., by Lot 509, Legaspi Cad.; on the S. and SW., by Lot 6049, Legaspi Cad. (the Manila Railroad Company); and on the NW., by Lots 1984, 1980 and 1979, Legaspi Cad., Road and Lots 1959, 1957 and 1956, Legaspi Cad.

containing an area of THIRTY ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY SIX (31,256) Square Meters, more or less.

“Lot 2 – Lot 19167, Legaspi Cad. 56

BOUNDED on the N. and NE., by Lot 6049, Legaspi Cad. (The Manila Railroad Company); on the SE., by Lot 1672 Legaspi Cad.; and on the S. and SW., by Lot 5 of plan Bsd-20022.

containing an area of ONE HUNDRED FIVE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED AND ONE (105,201) Square Meters, more or less.

“Lot 5 – Lot 19171, Legaspi Cad. 56

BOUNDED on the N., by Lot 6049, Legaspi Cad. (The Manila Railroad Company) and Lot 2 of plan Bsd-20022; on the NE., by Lot 2 of Plan Bsd-20022; on the SE., by Creek; and on the SW., by Lots 6 and 4 of plan Bsd-20022.

containing an area of FOURTEEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED AND SIXTY SEVEN (14,267) Square Meters, more or less.”
