

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ON THE RECOGNITION OF TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION OF SEAFARERS BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES AS REPRESENTED BY THE MARITIME TRAINING COUNCIL AND THE GOVERNMENT OF IRELAND AS REPRESENTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNICATIONS, MARINE AND NATURAL RESOURCES

1. This agreement is made pursuant to paragraph 1.2 of Regulation I/10 of the International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers, 1978, as amended (the STCW Convention) and Section A-I/10 of the STCW Code between the Maritime Training Council representing the Republic of Philippines Administration and the Department of Communications, Marine and Natural Resources representing the Government of Ireland.

2. It is agreed that the Republic of Philippines Administration shall recognize the certificates of competency issued by the Government of Ireland under the STCW Convention as amended in accordance with Regulation 1/1 0 of the said Convention subject to the terms and condition of this agreement.
