THE TENTH PROTOCOL ON SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNOLOGICAL COOPERATION BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES

- 1. In accordance with the Agreement on Scientific and Technological Cooperation between the Government of the People's Republic of China and the Government of the Republic of the Philippines signed in Manila on March 14, 1978, the Sino-Philippine Joint Committee on Scientific and Technological Cooperation {hereinafter referred to as the Joint Committee) held its tenth session in Beijing, China, on June 23-26, 1994. The Chinese Delegation (hereinafter referred to as "the Chinese side") was headed by Mr. Han Deqian, Vice Chairman of the State Science and Technology Commission (SSTC) while the Philippine Delegation (hereinafter referred to as "the Philippine side") was headed by Dr. Federico Macaranas, Undersecretary of the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA).
