PROTOCOL TO IMPLEMENT THE THIRD PACKAGE OF COMMITMENTS ON FINANCIAL SERVICES UNDER THE ASEAN FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT ON SERVICES

The Governments of Darussalam, the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Republic Indonesia. Lao People's Democratic Republic, Malaysia, the Union of their specific commitments under Myanmar, the Republic of the Philippines, the Republic Kinadom Singapore, the of Thailand, and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam, Member States of the Association of South East Asian Nations (hereinafter referred to as "ASEAN");

ASEAN NOTING the Framework Agreement on Services signed on 15 December 1995 in Bangkok, Thailand, which seeks to enhance cooperation in services among Member States, eliminate substantially restrictions to trade in services among Member States and liberalize trade in services expanding the depth and scope of liberalization beyond those undertaken by Member States under the General Agreement on Trade Services (hereinafter in referred to as "GATS"} of the World Organization Trade (hereinafter referred to as "WTO");

RECALLING that the Sixth ASEAN Finance Ministers Meeting called on Member States to enter into a third round of negotiations in financial 2002 services, beginning and ending 2004;

HAVING carried out negotiations in financial services pursuant to Article IV ASEAN of the Framework Agreement on Services and finalized the package of commitments under

Brunei HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

- of 1. Member States who are WTO Members shall continue to extend GATS to ASEAN Member States who of are non-WTO members.
 - 2. Member States shall extend to all other Member States preferential treatment in financial services as set forth in the Schedules of Specific Commitments annexed to this Protocol.
 - 3. The Annexes to this Protocol shall of the Horizontal Commitments, Schedules of Specific Commitments and the Lists of Most-Favored Nation Exemptions.
 - 4. This Protocol and its Annexes shall form an integral part of the ASEAN Framework Agreement on Services.
 - 5. This Protocol shall enter into force the deposit upon of of ratification instruments or acceptance by all signatory governments with the Secretary-General of ASEAN, which shall be done not later than 31 December 2005.
 - 6. This Protocol shall be deposited Secretary-General with the ASEAN who shall promptly furnish a copy thereof certified to each Member Country. The Secretary-General of **ASEAN** shall also promptly furnish notifications ratifications or acceptances made pursuant to paragraph 5 to each Memben Country.
