AMENDMENT TO D.O. 14-2015 ON EXTENDING THE VALIDITY OF PHILIPPINE PASSPORTS

Adopted: 09 October 2015 Date Filed: 16 October 2015

As amendment to Department Order No. 14-2015, in order to render effective service to passport extension applicants who may have passports which expired for more than two (2) years, as well as to grant a two-year validity period extension for OFW passport extension applicants as required by their respective employers, D.O. 14-2015 is hereby amended as follows:

"xxx

The extension of the validity of passports is for a period of not less than one (1) year but not more than two (2) years **from the date of application for extension.** The extension shall only be granted to applicants whose applications were submitted not later than 30 December 2015.

XXX''

This Order shall immediately supersede D.O. 14-2015 as far as the change as indicated above, and all previous instructions issued on the subject.
