GUIDELINES IN THE ISSUANCE OF MISSION LETTER/ORDER AND POLICY ON CARRYING FIREARMS

Adopted: 03 January 2014 Date Filed: 23 January 2014

In line with the streamlining of policies of this Office, all LTO Regional Directors are hereby authorized to approve Mission Letter/ Mission Order of their respective Region's Law Enforcers, pursuant to Section 7.13.6 of the newly published and issued Implementing Rules And Regulations of Republic Act No. 10591 dated May 29, 2013, otherwise known as "The Comprehensive Law on Firearms and Ammunition And Providing Penalties for Violations thereof, relative to the carrying of firearms, to wit:

- 1. Government firearm holders are allowed to carry their firearms outside of residence when they are covered with a Mission Letter/ Order issued by the Authorized Official.
 - a) The bearer of the mission letter/ order shall sign an undertaking immediately below the signature of the issuing authority to the effect that the mission letter/ order holder is certifying that he has read and fully understood the contents of his/her mission order and binds himself/herself to strictly abide by and comply with the instructions contained therein.
 - b) Only agents, who are in regular plantilla of the government agency involved in law enforcement and are receiving regular compensation for the services rendered in the agency, are allowed to be issued letter/mission order. Further, a civilian agent must be included in a specific law enforcement/ police/intelligence project proposal or special project which specifically requires the use of firearms to ensure its accomplishment and that the project is duly approved at the Police Regional Office Level or its equivalent level in major services of the AFP and NBI or at higher level Command.
- 2. Members of the law Enforcement Services of the Land Transportation Office (LTO) are authorized to carry their issued firearms while on duty within their respective operations only.

After their tour of duty, the firearms should be returned to the property custodian for safekeeping in the depository. In case of missions outside of their official stations, they may be allowed to carry their duly issued firearms provided they are covered by a MISSION ORDER stating in the period and places covered.
