- 1. Customs Memorandum Order No. 18-2014, Guidelines on Lifting an Order of Abandonment, is repealed, in response to legitimate concerns on the practicality of its implementation.
- 2. Requests for lifting of abandonment should be made in accordance with procedures existing prior to the issuance of CMO 18-2014.
- 3. The Office of the Commissioner shall consult with various affected stakeholders and operating divisions within the BOC in the coming weeks, and will issue new guidelines thereafter.
- 4. This CMO is effective immediately.
