

[PRC RESOLUTION NO. 2005-267, February 11, 2005]

RATES OF FEES AUTHORIZED BY LAW TO BE COLLECTED BY THE PROFESSIONAL REGULATION COMMISSION

Pursuant to Executive Order No.197 dated January 13, 2000 and Section 1 of Republic Act No.465, as amended by R.A. No. 6511, in relation to Section 7 (g) of R.A. No.8981, the rates of fees to be collected by the Commission, as approved by the Office of the President, are as follows:

A. Examination	RATE
1. Licensure Examination	
a. Requiring Baccalaureate Degree	P 900.00
b. Requiring Baccalaureate Degree with Practical Examination / Assessment (except Marine Deck and Marine Engineer Officers)	1,300.00
c. For Non-Baccalaureate Degree	600.00
d. For Marine Deck and Marine Engineer Officers:	
d.1 Written (Theoretical) Examination	900.00
d.2 Practical Assessment (after passing the Written [Theoretical] Examination)	400.00

(Nota bene: An examinee who, for whatever reasons, failed to report and take the scheduled examination, shall forfeit the fee or fees paid for such examination)

2. Re-examination

a. Written (Theoretical) Examination	900.00
b. Practical Examination/Assessment	400.00

(Nota bene: Conditionally passed Examination is taken by an examinee who took a licensure examination with practical examination/assessment [e.g. Dentistry, Optometry, Marine Deck or Marine Engineer Officers] but only passed either the written [theoretical] or practical examination/assessment.

c. Removal Examination in Subject/s where Examinee Failed:	450.00
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(Nota bene: Removal Examination is taken by an examinee who obtained a passing general average grade or more but obtained a disqualifying grade/s of less than 65%, 60% or 50% as the case maybe, in any of the subjects. However, in Accountancy, removal examination shall be taken by an examinee who obtained grades of 75% or more in at least four (4) subjects but obtained failing grades in the other subjects.)

3. Ocular Pharmacology as provided under Sec. 31, R.A. No.8050 (Optometry Law)	1,500.00
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4. Licensure Examinations to be conducted outside the Philippines:

a. Requiring Baccalaureate Degree	US\$ 40.00
b. Requiring Non-Baccalaureate Degree	US\$ 30.00
c. For removal examination	US\$ 25.00

(Nota bene: The above provisions are necessary for giving examination/s without practical examination/assessment outside the Philippines)

B. Registration (Initial and Others)

1. For Professions Requiring Baccalaureate Degree	P 600.00
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2. For professions/occupations requiring non-baccalaureate degree	450.00
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3. Issuance of Temporary/Special Permit to Para-Teachers
under Section 26 (last proviso) of R.A. No. 7836:

a. Initial issuance of Temporary/Special Permit (three [3] year validity at P200 per year)	600.00
b. Issuance (last) of Temporary/Special Permit (five [5] year validity at P200 per year)	1,000.00

4. Issuance of Temporary/Special Permit or, when appropriate, Certificate of Registration and Professional Identification Card to Foreign Professionals:

a. Issuance of Temporary/Special Permit to former Filipino citizens who are allowed to practice their professions under P.D. No.541 while on a visit, sojourn or when they reside permanently in the Philippines:

a.1 For each visit or sojourn	1,250.00*
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a.2 For permanent residents 1,500.00*

(Nota bene: For purposes of the fees to be collected, visit or sojourn shall be for a duration of not more than six (6) months for each visit or sojourn)

b. Issuance of Temporary/Special Permit to Foreign Professionals covered by Section 7(j) and (l) of R.A. No.8981 (except for professionals in Medical/Humanitarian Missions) 1,500.00*

c. Issuance of Temporary/Special permit to Foreign Health Professionals on a Medical/Humanitarian Mission in the Philippines for a limited period. 1,250.00

(Nota bene: The duration of "limited period" shall not exceed one (1) month but may be extended for the same or shorter period when justified by circumstances)

d. Issuance of Certificate of Registration Foreign Professionals who Qualify to practice their Profession in the Philippines on basis of reciprocity 1,500.00

e. Issuance of Certificate of Registration or Temporary/ Special Permit to Foreign professionals engaged/hired/employed to work in the Philippines pursuant to the provisions of specific Philippine laws and International agreements. 1,500.00*

f. Issuance of Certificate of Registration or Temporary/ Special Permit whichever is applicable to Foreign professionals other than those covered by (a), (b), (c), (d), and (e) above, but are nonetheless covered by Section 1 of PRC Resolution No.547, Series of 1998 as amended by PRC Resolution No.549 series of 1998 1,500.00

g. Issuance of Professional Identification Card to Foreign Professionals Issued Certificate of Registration/Temporary/ special Permit under No.4 (a.2), (b), (d), (e), and (f) above (three [3] year validity at P150 per year) 450.00*

5. Detailman under Sec. 12 Art. III of R.A. No.5921 (Pharmacy Law):

a. Initial Registration 300.00

b. Annual Registration [three (3) year validity at P150 per year] 450.00

C. Annual Registration of Professionals as

Provided under Section 1 of R.A. No.465, as amended by R.A. No.6511, and Issuance of Professional Identification Card

1. Registered Professionals with Baccalaureate Degree [three (3) year validity at P150 per year]	450.00
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2. Registered Professionals with Non-Baccalaureate[three (3) year validity at P140 per year]	420.00
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D. Registration Without Examination

1. Filing and processing of application:	
a. Baccalaureate Degree	900.00
b. Non-Baccalaureate Degree	600.00

2. Registration after approval of application:	
a. Baccalaureate Degree	600.00
b. Non-Baccalaureate Degree	450.00

1. Issuance of Certificate for passing examination in Ocular Pharmacology	1,200.00
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2. Issuance of Certifications, per certification	75.00
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3. Authentication of documents:	
a. One (1) page document	75.00
b. Document with more than one (1) page but not exceeding twenty (20) pages, rate of one (1) page document plus P20 per additional page.	
c. Document with more than twenty (20) pages but not exceeding fifty (50) pages, rate of one (1) page document plus P15 per additional page	
d. Document with more than fifty (50) pages, rate of one (1) page document Plus P10 per additional page	

4. Other Certifications

a. Certification attesting to the fact that a person has passed a licensure examination (not a license to practice):	
a.1 in the form of diploma (certificate with picture)	500.00
a.2 in plastic card form (with picture)	600.00
